

WE THE PEOPLE TN MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

We the People TN is a non-profit educational membership organization and therefore is made up of individual members. Each member of the organization must agree to a code of conduct, as follows:

- The member will always speak and act in accordance with “the golden rule” from the scriptures (Matthew 7:12) and with “the three loves” from the scriptures (Matthew 22:37-39, John 13:34) when involved in any activity where the member is representing the organization or where the member is participating with the organization.
- The member will support and defend the United States (federal) and Tennessee (state) constitutions according to their original intent.
- The member will always dress in a modest manner appropriate to the specific meeting or event.
- The member, if carrying a firearm while representing the organization or where the member is participating with the organization, must always comply with all Constitutional local, state, and federal laws.
- The member will support the organization’s purpose by:
 - Participation in classes and events.
 - Participation in committees.
 - Engagement in positive social media interactions.
 - Participation in local political and community activities.
 - Contribution of time and resources.
 - Encouragement of others to join.
- The member will pay annual membership fees on-time.
- The member’s membership may be terminated for violation of the Code of Conduct above, for non-payment of membership dues as required in the organization bylaws, or upon the member’s request.
